## **TYPICAL DUTIES:**

Tasks include but are not limited to: tree trimming and removal, sanitation, street sweeping, street patching, snow removal, buildings, grounds, athletic field and park maintenance, as well as other related duties as assigned. Must pass physical, drug screening and background check.

Employee will be a shared employee of both the DPW and Parks Departments. Work is assigned and outlined by oral and written instructions of the Parks and Recreation Director, The Superintendent of Public Works, Deputy Director of Public Works and / or the DPW Foreman.

Employee will be a member of the TPOAM Union. P-1 classification will be effective for a minimum of 1 year, the probationary period for a "new hire" within this department (DPW).

- 1. Possesses or can obtain Commercial Driver's License Class B w/air brakes endorsement within 6 months of hire.
- 2. You must possess a valid Michigan driver's license with a good driving record.
- 3. Experience in the safe operation of a bucket truck, tree trimming and tree removal.
- 4. Ability to operate heavy equipment. Experience in the operation of underslung plow, front plow truck, salt spreader, road grader, and front-end loaders.
